MAY SHOWJUMPING SCHOOL WITH LES BUNNING (W.A.)

It is a pleasure to advise that this school had the biggest number of entries for a few years with 5 classes. PERPETUAL TROPHY

Each year the Darwin Show Jumping Club keeps a points score for a horse/rider combination. The horse/rider combination with the largest number of points wins a large silver cup which they keep for one year. Points are taken from all jumping events at the main gymkhanas and shows in Darwin. As soon as we have results for the first couple of shows we will keep you posted as to whom is in the lead.

This event is listed in the program for Fred's Pass Rural Show. A few people have asked me what this jumping event entails. Basically it is one round over a course and the fastest time wins. However, if you knock a rail penalties are added in the form of time to your score. Having watched this at the SA Showjumping Championships in Adelaide at Christmas time it turned out that the winners were the only ones who jumped clear and had a slightly slower time. This just goes to show that speed isn't always the winner!
