A quick tip

Saluting.

There are still a few riders out there who do not salute the judge, or if they are it's not an obvious salute. The judge can ELIMINATE you if you do not salute.

Riders do not need to wait for the bell to Salute the judge. If you are near the judge, just make eye contact and salute, then you can carry on preparing to start after you've heard the bell. If you hear the bell and you have not saluted yet, you should then look toward the judge and salute prior to starting your round. You should make your salute obvious, so that there is no confusion as to whether or not you have saluted.

Riders should be aware that with the Royal Show coming up in July and the NT Show Jumping Championships in August, that the judges at these events may be not be as forgiving as they have been so far this year, and if you don't remember to salute, it could all end up in tears!!!!

Thanks to Pam's hard work the club has some new jump poles. Having bought the poles Pam arranged for the prison community services to come out to Fred's Pass to paint them for us. So look out for the eye catching new poles at the next event.

DSJC is going to apply for a volunteer's grant—so if anyone has any ideas of things that would make the volunteer's life easier email it to Jane (can't be anything for the club—so no jumping equipment. The committee is thinking of eskies, drink containers, shade, chairs but please if you think of anything else let me know.

Volunteers are needed on Monday 24th—about 8am—this is when to Royal Show committee pick up the jump trailer. We are looking for a couple of people to help, supervise, pull the trailer out of the shed and generally be supportive. Please contact either Pam or Karen if you feel you can help.

A fun day planned for the 27th August. We had a few suggestions for new classes (such as a class where a horse is ridden by parent and child—with one round being much easier than the other.) We are looking for other ideas as well, so put your thinking caps on and let us know what you think up.

The committee is looking for sponsorship for the NT Championships to enable prize money to be handed out. \$50 would allow for a first prize of \$30 and second prize of \$20. The sponsor's name would appear in the program and in the newsletter , so can everybody try and find someone to sponsor a class.
